RECOMMENDATIONS

That the sub committee determines the application for the variation of the Premises Licence.

1. SUMMARY OF REPORT

1.1 An application was received for the variation of the Premises Licence under the Licensing Act 2003 at Loves Café, West Street, Weston super Mare. The application made is to increase the licensable hours for the sale of alcohol, live music, recorded music, films and late night refreshment. Consultations have been carried out and a representation has been received by Avon & Somerset Police requesting revised times and additional conditions. These have been agreed by the applicant and are required to be approved by the Licensing Sub-Committee.

2. POLICY

2.1 The Council's statement of Licensing Policy applies to this application.

2.2 The Licensing Act 2003 requires licensing authorities to carry out their functions with a view to promoting the following four licensing objectives:

- a) The Prevention of Crime and Disorder.
- b) Public Safety.
- c) The Prevention of Public Nuisance, and
- d) The Protection of Children from Harm.

2.3 The Licensing Authority should have regard to the Statutory Guidance issued under section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003, and the provisions of the Licensing Act itself.

3. DETAILS

3.1 An application was received on the 9th March 2018 from Miss Anna Southwell for the variation of the Premises Licence under the Licensing Act 2003, in respect of Loves Café, West Street, Weston super Mare. A copy of the application that has been made is shown at **Appendix A**.

3.2 The premise comprises of a ground floor café with a first-floor mezzanine level and is operated as a coffee/bar/bistro style venue.

3.3 Loves Café has both commercial and residential properties within 100 metres of the licensed premises.

3.4 A copy of a location plan of the premises is shown at **Appendix B**.



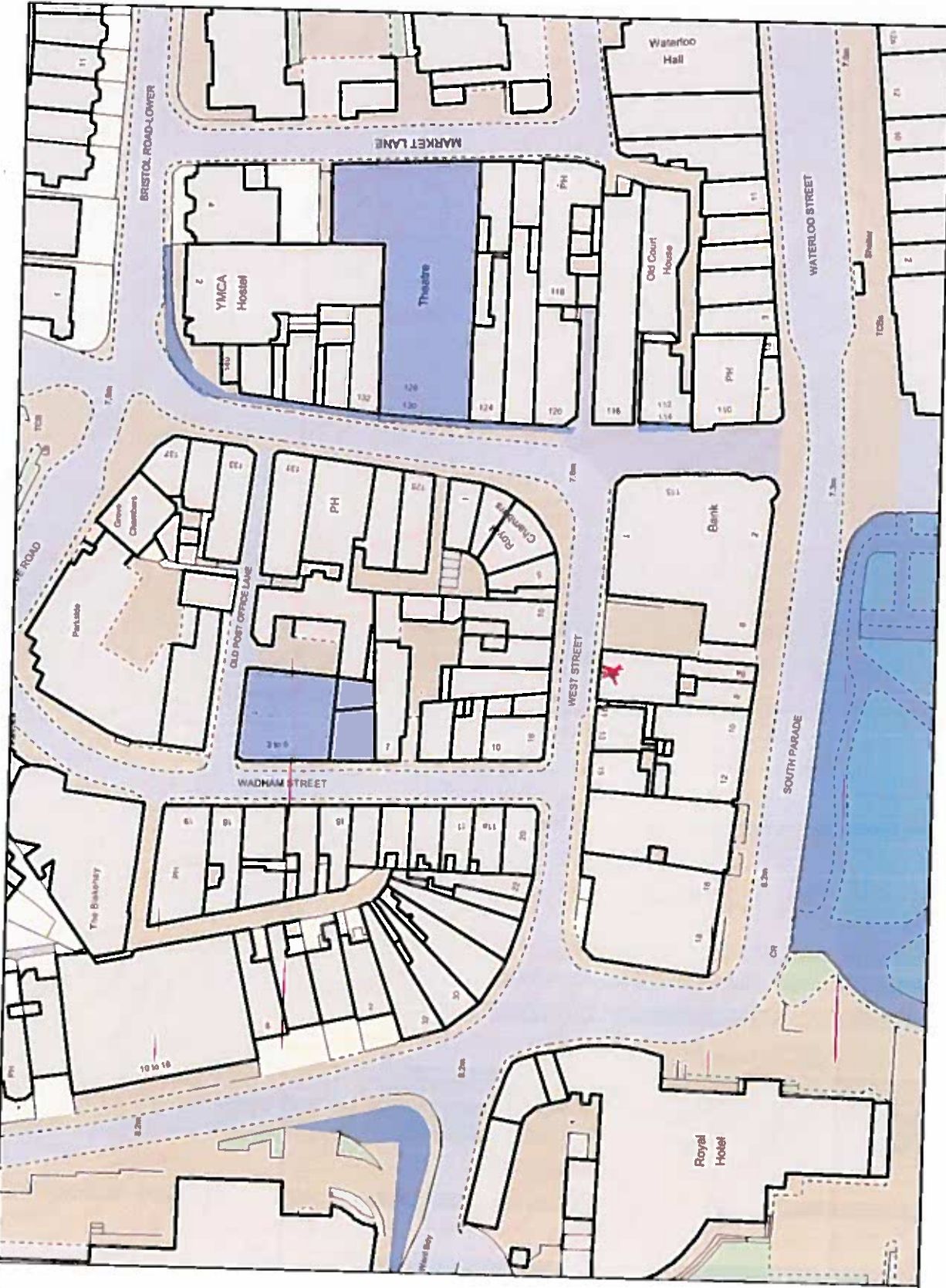

Please state yes or no.</p>	<p>The police, as a responsible authority, make a relevant representation to the variation application for the above premise as they believe if granted in its current form it could have an adverse effect on the Licensing Objectives. Currently the hours for Licensable Activities/the hours the premise is open at the premise is 0700 hours until 2345 hours with the exception of Sundays when the hours are 1000 hours until 1800 hours. The application is to extend the opening hours/Licensable Activities hours from 0700 hours until 0030 hours Monday to Wednesday and from 0700 hours until 0230 hours Thursday to Sunday.</p> <p>The premise itself consists of a ground floor with a first floor mezzanine level and is operated as a Coffee Bar/ Bistro style venue with very limited room for vertical drinkers.</p> <p>The current operator has been at the venue ever since the premise license was granted during which time a number of temporary event notices have been held at the venue permitting Licensable Activities until 0230 hours none of which have caused any issues in relation to the Licensing Objectives that the police are aware of.</p> <p>The location of this venue falls within the Cumulative Impact Area which puts the onus on the applicant to prove that this variation will not adversely affect the Licensing Objectives.
